

RESOLUTION NO. 10-001

A RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THE THEMES AND POLICIES COMPONENT OF THE 2010 JACKSON/TETON COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AS PART OF THE COMPREHENSIVE MASTER PLAN FOR THE TOWN OF JACKSON, WYOMING AND TETON COUNTY, WYOMING

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Jackson and the Teton County Board of Commissioners jointly agreed to update the 1994 Jackson/Teton County Comprehensive Plan and entered into a contract for planning services outlining joint funding and support to develop an integrated plan for the future on June 21st, 2007; and

WHEREAS, Wyoming Statutes §§ 15-1-503, 15-1-504, and 15-1-505 authorize the Town of Jackson Planning Commission to amend, adopt, and certify to the Mayor and Town Council a master plan for the physical development of the municipality; and Wyoming Statutes § 18-5-202 authorizes the Teton County Planning and Zoning Commission to amend and certify to the Teton County Board of Commissioners a comprehensive plan for promoting the public health, safety, morals and general welfare of the incorporated area of Teton County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said authority the Town of Jackson Planning Commission and the Teton County Planning and Zoning Commission have jointly prepared the Themes and Policies Component of the 2010 Jackson/Teton County Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Themes and Policies Component of the 2010 Jackson/Teton County Comprehensive Plan was prepared through an extensive public process that included community polling, kickoff interviews, community workshops, Stakeholder Advisory Group and Technical Advisory Group meetings, community and neighborhood presentations, newspaper advertisements for all meetings, an interactive website, and taskforces to determine buildout numbers and employee generation; and

WHEREAS, the first public hearing was advertised on May 6, 2009, announcing the joint meeting of the Town of Jackson Planning Commission and the Teton County Planning and Zoning Commission on June 11, 2009, and included the various means for citizens to review the plan and provide comments prior to the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Jackson Planning Commission and the Teton County Planning and Zoning Commission jointly conducted public hearings, pursuant to the Wyoming Statutes recited above, on the following dates:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Jackson Planning Commission hereby amends the 1994 Jackson/Teton County Comprehensive Plan and adopts and certifies to the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Jackson the attached Themes and Policies Component of the 2010 Jackson/Teton County Comprehensive Plan (the “Themes and Policies”); and the Teton County Planning and Zoning Commission hereby amends the 1994 Jackson/Teton County Comprehensive Plan and certifies to the Teton County Board of Commissioners said Themes and Policies; which Themes and Policies are comprised of the following documents:



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town of Jackson Planning Commission and the Teton County Planning and Zoning Commission certifies to the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Jackson, and the Teton County Board of Commissioners (the “elected officials”), respectively, the following further recommendations as part of their certification of the Themes and Policies Component of the 2010 Jackson/Teton County Comprehensive Plan (the “Themes and Policies”):

- That, the elected officials request, as soon as they deem appropriate, that the Town of Jackson Planning Commission and Teton County Planning and Zoning Commission (the "joint planning commissions") certify the Future Land Use Plan Component of the 2010 Jackson / Teton County Comprehensive Plan (the “FLUP”) to the elected officials, and that the elected officials would wait to adopt the 2010 Jackson / Teton County Comprehensive Plan in its entirety upon the joint planning commissions' certification of the FLUP.
- That, the elected officials consider the attached composite list of inconsistencies in the Plan that have been identified by individual Planning Commissioners but deemed irreconcilable.
