### Objectives:

- 1 Present town plan policy direction, maps, and planning process (e.g., upcoming meetings)
- 2 Discuss town focus areas and directions informally at workstations  
*(Note: Public meeting on May 15<sup>th</sup> will focus on countywide map and policy directions.)*
- 3 Give public an opportunity to take information and provide comments through Summer '08

### Proposed Format/Agenda:

- **First 20 minutes (at 2:00 and 4:00): Brief Orientation Presentation**  
Presentation will orient participants to plan document, maps, and give brief overview of where we are in the process, including town planning effort, and how public can continue to comment throughout Summer '08.
- **Drop-in Format - Small groups (self-guided comments)**  
Materials will be available at tables, focusing on different areas addressed in the "Town Subarea Worksheet" packet and maps. Participants will be able to work individually using the worksheets and post comments on boards or tell comments to staff person at the station who will take notes. Proposed stations include:
  1. Gateway (South Highway 89)
  2. Downtown (including Town Square, Downtown commercial)
  3. Residential/mixed-use areas (Incl. S. Park Loop, the "Y", hillside N. of "Y", NoBro, office and residential areas just beyond core)
  4. Local corridors (Redmond, South Cache)
  5. Residential Neighborhoods (preservation areas)
- **Individual Comments:**  
Individuals will be able to provide comments either with a comment form or on-line after the meeting and participate in upcoming neighborhood meetings.
